Know that this is for you. *God never gives second-hand messages*. If this is in front of you today, it is for a reason. Read it now.

## **Choose Wisely**

Every one of us is going to die. It may be in 50 years or in 5 minutes. We don't know when and chances are we won't have a clue it is coming.

When death comes it won't be the end of us; it will simply end our time on earth. Whether you believe in God or not, you will exist after your death. The difference is in how you will exist. There are two choices. We can choose to be in heaven on streets of gold praising God and surrounded by His glory. Or, we can be in a fiery furnace where there is weeping and gnashing of teeth.

Where will you be?

There is only one way to get to Heaven, and that is through Jesus Christ. Accepting Jesus as your Savior is the only way to spend eternity in heaven. Just going to church or being a good person won't get you there. Only by accepting the sacrifice of Jesus on the cross, inviting Him into your heart, and having a personal relationship with Him can you be saved.

Romans 10:9 tells us "that if you confess with your mouth, 'Jesus is Lord,' and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved."

God is perfect, holy and righteous. The only way to be with Him is to be perfect, holy and righteous. Not one of us can do that. We can't even come close. We are all sinners. Separation from God (eternal damnation) is the punishment for our sins. But because God loves us so much and wants to be with us, He gave us a way to Him. He gave us Himself in Christ, coming to earth as man, living a perfect and blameless life, and accepting a sentence of death and damnation that He didn't deserve. He accepted that sentence for us. He died to pay the price for our sins and save us. His blood covers our sins and makes us acceptable to God.

What choice will you make?

If you die and have not accepted Christ as your savior, you will not go to heaven. You will be in the fiery furnace where there is weeping and gnashing of teeth. Know that not choosing is making a choice. Also know that there are no second chances after death and no guarantees of a last-minute opportunity to change your mind.

Please open your heart now. Dig as deep as you can to find the place in you that yearns for something more and cries out for your Creator. Do not let another moment go by without searching for the truth that lies in your soul. And when you find it, speak out the words below from the depths of your heart, soul and being.

Dear God, I know I am a sinner and my sin separates me from you. Thank you that Jesus Christ died in my place so that my sins could be forgiven. Dear Jesus, please forgive my sins. Come into my life and change my heart. Guide me in your ways and show me the truth. Make me new and let me live for you each day. Thank you for saving me and giving me eternal life. In Jesus' precious and holy name, Amen.
